



## CHRISTMAS ENVELOPE POCKET CARD BY WENDY MCGLINCHEY

### Step 1

Cut your A4 sheet of coloured card into two pieces measuring 4" x 11". Score each piece in the centre at 5.5". Take the first piece and cut diagonally from the top centre score line to the bottom right hand corner. Take the second piece and cut diagonally from the top centre score line to the bottom left hand corner. Using double sided tape stick the two pieces together by attaching one rectangle onto another. The diagonal pieces now fold forward to make the front of the card.

### Step 2

Take your two pieces of patterned paper and cut them diagonally corner to corner. Using double sided tape stick one piece of each on to the front triangular pieces. Add double sided tape across the bottom of the centre panel and fold your right hand piece of card in to stick down. Add double sided tape to the inside of the left hand piece along the bottom and about a third of the way up the diagonal side, fold this across over the first. This has now formed your pocket and the card should look like the back of an envelope with the flap cut off.

### Step 3

For your card insert take your white piece of card measuring 3.5" x 4.75" and either round the corners off or decorate with photo corners. Stamp the present/gifts image from Christmas Set 6 using black Versafine ink in the bottom left hand corner. Stamp the Merry Christmas greeting in the top right hand corner and 25th Dec text in the bottom right corner. Colour the present/gifts image with pens or pencils of your choice. Add a few gold peel off stars for decoration. Cut a short piece of the ribbon and adhere to the back of this piece of card. Attach this to the second insert piece of card measuring 3.75" x 5" (with corners rounded if this step was taken for the first piece) sandwiching the ribbon pull between layers.

### Step 4

Using double sided tape attach the wide ribbon around the pocket card joining tidily at the back. Cut a separate length of ribbon and tie to this at the left hand side.

### Step 5

Stamp the bauble stamp from Christmas Set 6 onto a piece of card, add colour with pens and cut the image out. Cover with Diamond Glaze and set aside to dry. Once dry add a little gold stickles glue to the bauble and once again allow to dry.

### Step 6

To finish attach the dry bauble embellishment to the ribbon with silicone glue or 3D Foam pads and pop the insert inside the pocket.

## MATERIALS

- Christmas Set 6 - R-CHR6
- Christmas Greetings (Sml) - RS-CHR5
- 1 x A4 coloured card to form
- 2 pieces of patterned paper (3.75" x 5")
- 3.75" x 5" piece of co-ordinating card
- 1 x 3.5" x 4.75" piece of white or cream card
- 1 metre of 1.5" wide ribbon to match
- Versafine black ink pad
- Double sided tape & 3D Foam pads
- Diamond Glaze
- Gold Stickles Glue
- Pens or pencils to add colour
